Pursuing the One Who Pursues You

There is no doubt that the Lord chases after us until He finds us. Not that we are ever lost from His sight, or have dropped from His GPS, but that we often attempt to hide, as if it were possible. It is a weak effort, one that leaves us feeling absent, alone and disassociated. So, He finds us there, hidden, but never out of His view, always within the grasp of His hands, although our temporary blindness leaves us perceiving otherwise. He is cognizant, and we are woefully unaware.

As He approaches the point of our revelation, He gently scrubs away scales from eyelids, dusts off the dirt and dust of sin, and baptizes us afresh and anew in the cleansing power of His Spirit.
