

Godliness

1 Timothy 4:6-16

The Point: A godly life points others to Christ.

The Bible Meets Life: You can tell a lot about people when you visit their home. When the mantle is lined with sports trophies and the walls are adorned with ribbons, you can tell the person is into sports. Or perhaps it's their bookshelves overflowing with books. Here's a person who is into reading. Walls covered with framed pictures of kids point to a person for whom family takes precedence. I might ask what in our homes points to a love for Jesus, but that's the wrong question. A lot of people might have a Bible on a bookshelf or a piece of artwork depicting Jesus, but those external things don't necessarily point to a love for Jesus. But when we live for Jesus, that makes all the difference.

Have you ever played the game Jenga? Think of it as the one Jenga piece apart from which the whole structure falls. The Bible points us to a quality that is that critical piece in our lives: godliness. Without godliness, the structure of our lives as believers falls apart. Our study will point our attention toward this crucial characteristic of godliness.

Live It Out: Examine yourself. Recall the last time you thought about heaven (such as attending a funeral, participating in a worship service, reading a devotional or the Bible). See if you can remember any response that provoked from you. Extend yourself. Think about your biggest obstacles in a pursuit of godliness. Consider ways to address those obstacles. **Inventory yourself.** Make a list of people upon whom you have, either by word or action, exerted positive influence. Ask your closest friend to help you make that list. See if you can find a visible token of that influence, such as a card or a note.
