

We believe in Jesus Christ. We believe He is the Savior of the world. That is why we gather and worship at this church. Quite frankly, that is why we do what we do. We do all we do because we love Christ. We know His love. We have experienced His love and we have given our lives to Him.

Is there a practical framework for making a difference for our guests, or those who live within commuting distance? The message is basic but profound. We want guests to know they are welcome here at Oakland. So, how do we communicate that message? How do we introduce the ministry of our church to guests? "We Want You Here" is a clear and instructive message we want everyone to hear. But how? We start by telling our neighbors, co-workers, fellow students, unchurched friends and family members, as well as guests:

- •This is Not a Place for Perfect People
- •Our Church Would Like to Get to Know You
- •This is Where Families Grow Strong
- •This is Where We All Get to Know the One Who Made Us
- •Come Make a Difference with Us
- •Thank You for Being Here

So, let's put our heads and hearts together and make our church a more welcoming church (we're already awesome). Our next sermon series is on being welcoming through working on ourselves, our hospitality, our service, our love & joy, and by going out to bring people in. It's not about slick or showy worship services. It's about being authentic and real among the real world. Let's do this! It's time to connect and engage!!

We are suggesting the following items for the next several weeks:






